Cheltenham Town Ladies suffer a tough defeat on the road after a late goal from hosts' Zoe Creaney.

A cagey opening 20 minutes set the tone for the game as both sides created half chances but nothing to trouble either number ones.

It was Cheltenham who came the closest in the first half, with Daisy Ackerman's cross finding Lily Billingham but the effort was saved by Chloe Sansom.

Despite the Robinesses' strong battle throughout, they fell victim to a late scramble that saw Creaney slot home.

A bright start from the Robinesses saw Maisy Collis and Henna Butcher link well but Butcher was unable to convert.

Butcher was in action again not long later, picking up a Don's misplaced pass, but the number 12's quick release saw Sansom scramble

back to her line just in time.

Following this scare, it was the hosts' turn to attack as they looked to strike from range, but Cheltenham captain Emily Owen provided a crucial block.

The fiery start from both sides continued as a strong run from Butcher won a free kick for Cheltenham. Ackerman floated in the set piece, clipping the head of Owen but the skipper couldn't keep her effort down.

The nervy opening 45 minutes ended with nothing to separate the two sides.

A fast restart from the hosts saw them go close but a crucial block from defender Holly Finch prevented them finding the net.

Moments later, the Robinesses looked to create a chance of their own after Ackerman wriggled through the defence to the edge of the

box, before letting go from range, but the wingback saw her effort saved.

With neither side yet to break the deadlock, the hosts continued to apply the pressure, with Cheltenham 'keeper Aimee Watson pulling off several vital saves from

An opener looked possible for Cheltenham after an Ackerman corner was recycled, before finding Owen but a scramble on the line from MK saw them clear the chance.

The home side would flip the game on its head, with Creaney scoring from another scramble, slotting well past Watson.

With just minutes to go, the Robinesses continued to push, with Emily Allen having free-kick appeals waved away.

Despite their best efforts, Davies' side fell to defeat on the road for the first time in 2024.
